Due to confidentiality, our office may only discuss the Order/Notice to Withhold Income for Child Support and the Notice to Withhold for Health Care Coverage. If your employee has questions regarding his/her case and he/she would like to contact our office, please refer him/her to:

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q.** How much am I required to deduct from an employee's earnings?
- A.** You must deduct the amount requested in the Order/Notice to Withhold Income for Child Support but never more than 50% of the employee's disposable earnings.
- Q.** What do I need to do if the obligor is no longer working or has never worked for our company?
- A.** Please complete the *Employer Response** form and return it to our office immediately.

Where do I send an employee's child support payment?

- Q.** How do I enforce a National Medical Support Notice/Notice to Withhold for Health Care Coverage (NMSN)?
- A.** Please add the child(ren) to the health insurance plan and return the *Plan Administrator Response* with the medical insurance form, insurance card(s) and/or booklets. If coverage is not available at this time, but will become available at a later date, please specify such date on the *Plan Administrator Response*, and return that form to our office. Please retain the NMSN and add the child (ren) to the health insurance plan once health insurance becomes available; then, complete and return the medical insurance form together with insurance card(s) and/or booklets.
- Q.** If the child support amount and health insurance cost combined exceed 50% of the employee's disposable earnings, do I add the child(ren) to the health insurance plan?

- A.** Please do not add the child(ren) to the health insurance plan. Return the *Employer Response** form with an explanation describing the employee's situation.
- Q.** How do I honor wage assignments for the same employee from both your office (Department of Child Support Services) and the Franchise Tax Board Collection Program (FTBCP)?
- A.** If you are honoring a wage assignment from the Department of Child Support Services and you receive an Earnings Withholding Order from the FTBCP for the same employee, please continue to honor our wage assignment and immediately call our office at (866) 901-3212, following the prompts for the Employer Line as previously described. We will notify the FTBCP to withdraw the employee from their program.

If you receive the Earnings Withholding Order from the FTBCP before our wage assignment, please honor the Earnings Withholding Order from FTBCP. Please complete #6 on the "*Additional Information To Employers and Other Withholders*" * form and return immediately to our office indicating this as the reason for return.

NOTE: The *Additional Information to Employers and Other Withholders* form must be returned within 30 days.

- Q.** What is the New Employee Registry (NER)?
- A.** The NER is a program of the Employment Development Department (EDD), which provides timely statewide information for child support enforcement purposes. EDD maintains the new and/or returning hire information received from employers on a database for approximately 180 days. With this information, child support agencies are authorized to serve the *Order/Notice to Withhold Income for Child Support* for those obligors who owe a duty of support.
- Q.** What are my responsibilities as an employer?
- A.** Employers are required to report information regarding their new or returning employees to EDD within 30 days from the hiring date.
- Q.** How do I report new employees to NER?

FTB Child Support Collections Program (FTBCP)

This program is designed to aid in the collection of current support and past due child support. If the obligor does not pay the arrears amount in full, collection actions are initiated. These actions may include an **Earnings Withholding Order** served on the non-custodial parent's place of employment.

The obligor may contact Customer Connect at 1(866) 901-3212 with questions regarding the FTB Child Support Collection Program.

Submitting Payments via EFT

If you are an employer who is already required to pay the Employment Development Department (EDD) or the Franchise Tax Board (FTB) using Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT), pursuant to Family Code §17309.5 you are now required to send child support payments to the SDU using EFT. For EFT/EDI payment processing, please visit www.casdu.com to set up your electronic payment account or contact the SDU at 1(866) 325-1010.

If you currently send payments directly to an individual, you must submit either a FL 195 (Order/Notice to Withhold Income for Child Support) or a completed DCSS 0116 (Child Support Case Information Form) for each affected employee prior to sending the payments to the SDU. Once this information is received, DCSS will send you a CSE case number which you will need to provide with every private wage withholding payment.
