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COUNTY CLERK-RECORDER ANNOUNCES NEW SERVICE AT SOUTH COUNTY BRANCH OFFICE

Fictitious business name statements are now being accepted for filing at the Orange County Clerk-Recorder Department's convenient south county branch office in Laguna Hills.

Many businesses operate under fictitious business names, commonly referred to as a DBA or "doing business as," which are required to be filed and renewed with the County Clerk-Recorder. Previously, the statements could only be filed at the department's main office in downtown Santa Ana.

People filing fictitious business name statements or those who need copies of statements can visit the Clerk-Recorder's branch office located in the Laguna Hills Civic Center, 24021 El Toro Road.

For the past two years, Orange County Clerk-Recorder Tom Daly has provided south county residents an easier and more convenient way to obtain and file many government documents.

Daly was elected in 2002. His office provides a variety of public services, including recording documents related to real property transactions, maintaining and issuing copies of birth, death and marriage certificates, issuing marriage licenses and performing civil wedding ceremonies. The department also oversees the Orange County Archives, a center for materials, research and education preserving Orange County history for the public.
