CLERK-RECORDER BRINGS CONVENIENCE TO NORTH ORANGE COUNTY

Orange County Clerk-Recorder Tom Daly will open a new branch office on Tuesday, Feb. 17, to provide more accessible and convenient services to residents in north Orange County.

The new branch office is located in historic downtown Fullerton at 201 N. Harbor Blvd. Regular business hours are 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., with ample free parking.

The opening of the North County branch office follows the successful operation of the department's South County branch office in the Laguna Hills Civic Center. That office has served more than 64,000 South County residents since opening in 2006.

North County branch office customers will be able to access many of the services provided by the Clerk-Recorder, including obtaining copies of birth, death or marriage certificates; obtaining a marriage license and having a civil marriage ceremony performed; filing a fictitious business name and recording a real property document.

"Our customers throughout North County will save precious time and miles with the much-shorter drive to this new office," Daly said. "The location is convenient to every city in North County—Anaheim, Buena Park, Brea, Fullerton, La Habra, Placentia and Yorba Linda—and I know customers will appreciate that we've provided free parking."

The Orange County Clerk-Recorder provides a variety of public services, including recording documents related to real property transactions, maintaining and issuing copies of birth, death and marriage certificates, issuing marriage licenses and performing civil wedding ceremonies. The department also files Fictitious Business Names and Notary Public oaths and bonds, and processes passport applications. The department oversees the Orange County Archives, a center for materials, research and education, preserving Orange County history for the public.
