OPEN HOUSE PLANNED FOR NEW CLERK-RECORDER BRANCH OFFICE

The public is invited to preview the new branch office of Orange County Clerk-Recorder Tom Daly on Friday, February 13, in historic downtown Fullerton.

The Open House will be held from 1 – 3 p.m. at 201 N. Harbor Blvd. in Fullerton. The office offers free parking and is convenient for North County residents living in Anaheim, Buena Park, Brea, Cypress, Fullerton, La Habra, La Palma, Placentia and Yorba Linda.

The first official day of business for the new office is Tuesday, February 17, with regular business hours of 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. As a special treat, the office will open three days earlier on Saturday, February 14, for couples with appointments to be married on Valentine's Day.

North County branch office customers will be able to access many of the services provided by the Clerk-Recorder, including obtaining copies of birth, death or marriage certificates; obtaining a marriage license and having a civil marriage ceremony performed; filing a fictitious business name and recording a real property document.

The opening of the North County branch office follows the successful operation of the department's South County branch office in the Laguna Hills Civic Center. That office has served more than 64,000 South County residents since opening in 2006.

The Orange County Clerk-Recorder provides a variety of public services, including recording documents related to real property transactions, maintaining and issuing copies of birth, death and marriage certificates, issuing marriage licenses and performing civil wedding ceremonies. The department also files Fictitious Business Names and Notary Public oaths and bonds, and processes passport applications. The department oversees the Orange County Archives, a center for materials, research and education, preserving Orange County history for the public.
