VOLUNTEER CUPIDS HELP MAKE VALENTINE'S DAY SPECIAL

Eager couples flocked to Fullerton on Valentine's Day to tie the knot on the sweetest day of the year.

Three dozen couples were married on Feb. 14, after Clerk-Recorder Tom Daly opened the Fullerton branch office on a Sunday especially for the weddings. Couples came from as far away as Canada and San Diego, Riverside, Los Angeles and Imperial counties.

Department staffers volunteered to work on Valentine's Day and will take compensatory time off during the regular work week. "I appreciate my staff's willingness to volunteer to work on Sunday in the name of romance," Daly said.

Fifty couples tied the knot on Valentine's Day last year, which fell on a Saturday. In 2008, with Valentine's Day on a Friday, 141 couples jammed Clerk-Recorder offices to be married. An average of 28 couples is married on a typical weekday.

The special wedding day helped celebrate the one-year anniversary of the department's newest branch office in historic downtown Fullerton. Another branch office is available to residents of south Orange County at the Laguna Hills Civic Center. Both branch offices offer convenient free parking.

The Orange County Clerk-Recorder provides a variety of public services, including recording documents related to real property transactions, maintaining and issuing copies of birth, death and marriage certificates, issuing marriage licenses and performing civil wedding ceremonies. The department also files Fictitious Business Names and Notary Public oaths and bonds, and processes passport applications. The department oversees the Orange County Archives, a center for materials, research and education, preserving Orange County history for the public.
