DALY HONORED AS MANAGER OF THE YEAR

The Orange Coast chapter of the Society for Advancement of Management has chosen Orange County Clerk-Recorder Tom Daly as its 44th Manager of the Year.

Daly earned the honor through his leadership in customer service and cost-efficiencies as the county's Clerk-Recorder since 2002, as well as for his accomplishments as mayor of Anaheim from 1992 to 2002.

"The Society has honored experts in various fields, not because they were the only people who did what they did, but because they did what they did well and were respected for it," said SAM President Des Colleran, who also sits on the society's international board of directors. "So it is with Tom Daly."

Past recipients include Walter Knott, founder of Knott's Berry Farm (1968); Dr. Arnold O. Beckman of Beckman Industries (1970); Dr. Jewel Plummer Cobb, former president of California State University Fullerton (1987); Orange County Assessor Webster Guillory (2000); and former Ambassador to Spain George Argyros (2001).

Daly will receive the award at a May 13 dinner at The Phoenix Club in Anaheim. He will be introduced by Stan Oftelie, former CEO of the Orange County Business Council and the group's 1995 Manager of the Year.

Among Daly's accomplishments highlighted by the group:

- 1) Developing a multi-county electronic recording delivery system called SECURE, which is managed by Orange County and co-owned by Los Angeles, Riverside and San Diego counties. Sacramento and Santa Barbara counties also are partners in the system, designed to serve the entire state.
- 2) Opening branch offices in Laguna Hills and Fullerton with free parking for easier access to his department's services for residents of North and South County.
- 3) Protecting consumers by sponsoring two new laws which bar the use of full Social Security numbers in recorded documents. Daly's leadership also led to an agreement by the Department of Defense to allow veterans to keep only partial SSNs on military discharge forms.
