Marriage Ceremony Appointments Still Available for Memorable Date

Couples eager to enshrine a memorable wedding date of 09-09-09 have only a few more days to make appointments for the Clerk-Recorder Department's special wedding facilities in Orange County. To date, more than 50 couples have signed up.

Wedding venues offered by the Clerk-Recorder Department recently ranked third among the most popular county locations for weddings in KTTV/Fox 11's HOTLIST survey—the only public facilities so honored!

Couples can choose among three ceremony locations: the marriage office in the elegant Old County Courthouse, 211 W. Santa Ana Blvd. in Santa Ana; the South Orange County branch office at the Laguna Hills Civic Center, 24031 El Toro Rd., Laguna Hills; and the newest branch office in historic downtown Fullerton at 201 N. Harbor Blvd., Fullerton.

Space is limited, so advance reservations are encouraged. Some appointments are still available for the Santa Ana and Laguna Hills locations, with several spots open for the Fullerton office. Walk-ins also are welcome.

Picking a numeric trifecta for a wedding date is very popular with couples "since it only happens every 100 years," Orange County Clerk-Recorder and Commissioner of Marriages Tom Daly said.

On 07/07/07, 312 couples betting the date would lead to an extra measure of luck married at Daly's Santa Ana facility. Last year (08/08/08) was also popular—375 couples married on the eights, which signify wealth and prosperity in Chinese cultures.
