The Orange County Workforce Investment Board (OCWIB) is releasing a Request For Proposals (RFP) for Program Year (PY) 2004-2005 Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Youth Program Services For South Orange County In-School Youth on August 30, 2004.

The OCWIB is seeking proposals from qualified organizations or individuals to address employment, training needs and skill deficiencies of economically disadvantaged and eligible In-School Youth ages 14 to 21 as defined in the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) 127(2) (c) who are South Orange County residents. Responses to this RFP process will be considered for a funding cycle beginning approximately November 1, 2004.

Proposals must be received by OCWIB staff on September 29, 2004, 3:00 p.m., in order to be considered for funding.
