1. BRIDGES reduces bullying, violence, prejudice and hate on school campuses throughout Orange County.
2. BRIDGES teaches students to be respectful of others who are different from them and prepares them to take a stand against intolerance.
3. Almost 49,000 students, parents and teachers were reached through the BRIDGES Program last year.
4. OC Human Relations provides free conflict resolution services to all residents of Orange County, helping people communicate peacefully.
5. More than 3,600 residents received mediation services in 2008-09.
