**Rebates Available for Low-Income Older Adult Homeowners and Renters**

(Santa Ana-CA) The Homeowner and Renter Assistance Rebate for 2006 is now available. Eligible California older adult homeowners and renters can receive a once-per-year rebate. The maximum rebate allowed for homeowners, based on the assessed value of the home, is \$472.60. For renters, the maximum one-time rebate is \$347.50. The deadline to complete and return the application is October 15, 2007.

You are eligible for this rebate if you: 1) were 62 years of age or older on or before December 31, 2006; or if you are blind; or if you are disabled; 2) you paid \$50 or more rent per month in 2006 or you owned and lived in your own home (mobile homes included) on December 31, 2006; 3) your total household income for 2006 was \$42,770 or less; and 4) you are a US Citizen, a designated alien, or qualified alien when you file the form.

The rebate application, with complete instructions, is available by calling the County of Orange Office on Aging Information and Assistance line at **1-800-510-2020 or 1-714-567-7500**. The instructions are also available in Spanish, Chinese, Vietnamese, and Korean. If you need assistance with filling out the application, volunteers are available at various sites throughout Orange County. This assistance is free and is available now through October 15, 2007. There is no need to pay a company to fill the form out.

To request the rebate application and instructions or to find out where to go for your free assistance, call the Information and Assistance line at **1-800-510-2020 or 1-714-567-7500**. The Information Specialists can also give you information on transportation, in-home care, housing, food, caregiving, adult day care, health insurance, legal assistance and much more.
