



# Boating Advisory

We would like to remind you that it is important to come to your vessel to check its condition after such a dramatic week of rain. Weather stations indicate we have received as much as seven inches of rain since Monday and many storm cells were accompanied by wind gust in excess of 40 knots.

That much water coupled with the winds adds substantial weight to your vessel and those stressors may have been enough to part or loosen dock lines. Furthermore, with all the debris coming off the trees, we have seen many scuppers and deck drains clogged. All these combinations can easily sink a small vessel or tender.

Marina crews have done an excellent job out on the docks during this turbulent week, but they need your assistance. With a break in the weather expected this weekend we encourage you to take the time to come to the Harbor to make sure those hatches are battened down.
