Dear Valued Customer:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that OC Waste & Recycling has established new procedures for accepting Treated Wood Waste (TWW) for disposal at the Orange County landfills. The Department of Toxic Substances Control stated:

On June 18, 2007 the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) passed new alternative management standards (AMS) for treated wood waste (TWW), which went into effect on July 1, 2007, and are intended to ease regulatory burden. Although hazardous waste generators are required to properly classify their waste through knowledge or laboratory analysis, generators of TWW can presume their TWW is hazardous waste and avoid expensive laboratory testing. Generators can then manage their waste in accordance with the AMS, including disposal at certain non-hazardous waste landfills. Upon acceptance at these certain landfills, the TWW, at that point, becomes non-hazardous (Health & Safety Code § 25150.8).

As a result of DTSC TWW disposal requirements, OC Waste & Recycling has highlighted the new steps you will need to take prior to transporting your TWW loads to Prima Deshecha Landfill. TWW is strictly prohibited for disposal at Olinda Alpha Landfill and Frank R. Bowerman Landfill. These steps are summarized in the enclosed *TWW fact sheet*.

OC Waste & Recycling fee booth staff and Waste Inspectors at the landfills have been trained on the new procedures and will also be available to answer questions, or refer you to Prima Landfill for proper disposal. We are committed to meeting all regulatory compliance requirements.
