

COUNTY OF ORANGE 2011 REDISTRICTING PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PLAN

Introduction

To further the County's commitment to promote public participation in the redistricting process, this Public Participation Plan has been developed to ensure the widest practicable participation and dissemination of pertinent redistricting information. To further that goal, the Board of Supervisors has established a Redistricting Committee. Notice of the March 10, 2011, and April 1, 2011, Committee meetings and of the availability of redistricting information has been sent to those organizations, media outlets, and interest groups listed on Attachment A to this Public Participation Plan (A copy of the notices are also attached as Attachment B and Attachment C respectively). This Public Participation Plan will include:

1. The Redistricting Committee will hold public meetings to solicit public input on communities of interest and general goals of the redistricting process; to allow public testimony on redistricting proposals submitted by members of the public, members of the Board of Supervisors, and Redistricting Committee members; and to allow the Redistricting Committee to publicly discuss issues concerning each redistricting proposal. The Redistricting Committee may modify any proposal during its public deliberations. The Redistricting Committee will recommend a redistricting plan to the Board of Supervisors for its consideration and possible approval. The schedule of Board of Supervisors and Redistricting Committee meetings is as follows:

Regular meetings of the Redistricting Committee will be held on February 10, March 10, April 1, May 12, June 30, and, if required, July 7, 2011, at 2 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors meeting room. Additional regular meetings will also be held on May 26, June 9, June 16 and June 23, 2011, at a locations and times to be approved by the Redistricting Committee. Additional meetings may be approved by the Redistricting Committee in order to facilitate public input.

The Board of Supervisors will then hold a public hearing on or about July 26, 2011 in the County Hall of Administration to consider the recommendation of the Redistricting Committee and to direct the County Surveyor to draft a redistricting ordinance. The Board may also hold an earlier public hearing on a to-be-determined date. The Board of Supervisors will hold another public hearing on or about September 13, 2011 to consider adoption of the redistricting ordinance.

A schedule of all meeting times, locations and agendas will be available at the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, 333 West Santa Ana Blvd., 10 Civic Center Plaza, Room 465, Santa Ana, CA. The telephone number is (714) 834-2206. Meeting information will also be on the County redistricting website.

2. A package of the Redistricting Demographic Submittal Kit will be available for free download on the County redistricting website as detailed below. Computer terminals with redistricting software will also be hosted at locations throughout the County for members of the public to use. A schedule of these locations and their office hours will be developed and released to the public prior to April 4, 2011. All members of the public are welcome to submit a redistricting proposal for consideration by the Redistricting Committee according to the timetable below.
3. The public will have access to all proposals submitted to the Redistricting Committee.

Redistricting Demographic Submittal Kit

It is anticipated that the following redistricting materials will be made available to the public:

1. A database of pertinent information from which plans may be developed. This will be available online, on compact disc (CD) in MS Excel, and in paper form and includes:
 - a. Total population and voting age population by age, race, and ethnicity, sorted by census tract and city/community;
 - b. Total population and voting age population by age, race, and ethnicity, sorted by city and community;
 - c. Total population and voting age population by city and community and 2001 Supervisorial district;
 - d. Numbers and percentages of registered voters including political affiliation, and numbers and percentages of Hispanic and Asian surnamed registrants sorted by census tract;
 - e. Voter turnout and results of recent Supervisorial elections by census tract.
2. List of County census tracts (with partial and split tracts where appropriate) including current Supervisorial district assignments, and location of tracts within incorporated cities and unincorporated areas.
3. List of cities and unincorporated communities in the County with a list of census tracts included in each (including partial and split tracts where appropriate).
4. Three (3) County base maps showing incorporated cities, unincorporated areas, census tracts, and current Supervisorial district boundaries.

5. California Elections Code Sections 21500-21506 regarding county redistricting.
6. Required forms for plan submittal.

The Redistricting Demographic Submittal Kit may be downloaded at no cost from the County’s website www.oc.ca.gov. Click on the Redistricting item on the center carousel or go directly to <http://egov.ocgov.com/ocgov/Government/Redistricting>. Branches of the Orange County Public Library have computers with internet access.

Those who do not have internet access may obtain copies of the Redistricting Demographic Submittal Kit at a nominal cost at the Center for Demographic Research California State University, Fullerton 2600 Nutwood, Suite 750 College Park Building, Fullerton, CA. General Instructions for Developing/Submitting a Proposed Redistricting Plan

- Elections Code §§ 21500 et seq. requires that the County be divided into five Supervisorial districts, as nearly equal in population as possible. The redistricting database provides information on the population of cities and unincorporated communities and areas, census tract or tracts split by city or community boundaries, and census block. A tract generally contains between 4,000 and 8,000 residents, although the population may vary from this number. For additional guidance, please see the California Elections Code materials in the Redistricting Demographic Submittal Kit and the discussion below.
- A redistricting plan may not violate applicable provisions of the Voting Rights Act, 42 U.S.C. § 1973(b). The Voting Rights Act prohibits denying protected minority groups an equal opportunity to participate in the political process and to elect representatives of their choice.

- The following factors may be considered in drawing boundaries: a) topography; b) geography; c) cohesiveness, contiguity, integrity, and compactness of territory; and d) community of interests of the districts.

- The public has two methods by which they may submit proposed plans: Hardcopy or Electronic. The following details the submittal requirements for each method:

A. **Hardcopy** Redistricting plan proposals **must** include the following submittal requirements:

1. A numerically ordered list of each census tract by City or unincorporated area and the Supervisorial district to which it is assigned. (A required form will be available.) If portions of a tract are assigned to two or more Supervisorial districts, list each census block located in each district. (The Center for Demographic Research will provide direction on how to complete the form if a tract is split between districts.) The list must be submitted in both hard copy and in MS Excel format on CD-ROM, if possible.
2. A summary table of elements of the plan. (A required form will be in the Redistricting Demographic Submittal Kit.)
3. A map outlining the proposed boundaries of **all five** Supervisorial districts labeled by District number. (A required map will be in the Redistricting Demographic Submittal Kit.) (While a proposal submitted for the Redistricting Committee's consideration must include proposed boundaries for all five Supervisorial districts, public input concerning individual districts is welcome.)
4. A narrative description of the proposed plan, preferably in 250 words or less. The narrative may include a description of how the plan complies with the General Instructions for Developing/Submitting a Proposed Redistricting Plan.
5. A proposal must include a contact name, address, telephone number and, if available, email address.

If, upon reviewing submitted plans, the County finds discrepancies between submitted base maps and submitted lists of census tracts and census blocks, the lists will prevail.

B. **Electronic** Redistricting plan proposals **must** follow the process submittal requirements:

1. Electronics plans **must** be submitted using the *Maptitude for Redistricting* software. Submitters may use the public computer workstations identified by the County or, if utilizing a personal version of the *Maptitude for*

Redistricting software, submitters may submit a complete redistricting plan proposal on CD by providing a numerically ordered list of each census block and the Supervisorial district to which it is assigned. (A schedule of the locations of the public computer workstations and their office hours will be developed and released to the public prior to April 4, 2011).

2. In order to submit a plan using the redistricting software, the software requires plans to have **five** districts; no non-contiguous areas; no unassigned areas; a contact name, address, phone number, and email address; and a narrative description of the proposed plan, preferably in 250 words or less. The narrative may include a description of how the plan complies with the General Instructions for Developing/Submitting a Proposed Redistricting Plan.

The Center for Demographic Research at California State University, Fullerton will provide computer workstations and staff assistance for those wishing to prepare redistricting plans. The Center is located at 2600 Nutwood, Suite 750, College Park Building, Fullerton, CA 92831-5404. The hours during which the Center will provide workstations and staff assistance are:

7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Mondays and Thursdays, April 4 – May 16
8:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. Tuesdays and Wednesdays April 5 - May 17
8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, May 18
8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Fridays, April 8 – May 13
10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. Saturdays, April 16, April 30, May 7, and May 14

Reservations for use of computer workstations are strongly recommended. Staff assistance in languages other than English is available by appointment. Please call (657)-278-4670 to make a reservation for use of computer workstations or to arrange for language assistance.

The County will also have public computer workstations available to access the redistricting software at locations throughout the County. A schedule of these locations and their office hours will be developed and released to the public prior to April 4, 2011.

Plan Submission and Review Process/Public Hearings and Meetings of the Redistricting Committee

In order to be considered by the Redistricting Committee, proposed redistricting plans must be received by 5:00 p.m. on May 18, 2011. **Neither the County nor CDR is responsible for rejection of proposals that are either not received by the deadline or are incomplete or that do not comply with the requirements herein.**

- **Hardcopy** proposals must be received in the offices of the Center for Demographic Research by 5:00 p.m. on May 18, 2011. Postmarks by that date are **not** acceptable **nor** are facsimile transmission **nor** emails. Plan submittals are to be made to the Center for Demographic Research, California State University, Fullerton 2600 Nutwood, Suite 750 College Park Building, Fullerton, CA 92831-5404.
 - **Electronic** proposals must be received by 5:00 p.m. on May 18, 2011. If you desire a verification e-mail that your plan was received, send an e-mail to ddiep@fullerton.edu. You will receive a verification e-mail response within one (1) business day.
- Proposed plans will be reviewed for accuracy of data and conformance with legal requirements before being provided to the Redistricting Committee. The time frame for analysis is dependent on the format of the submission. Copies of staff analysis will be available upon request.
 - Plans that have been revised as a result of staff analysis may be resubmitted. Resubmissions are subject to the 5:00 p.m., May 18, 2011 deadline. Therefore, original submissions must be received in sufficient time to allow for review, revision, and resubmission. Any initial plans submitted after 5:00 p.m. on May 4, 2011 cannot be analyzed and returned for resubmission because of deadline constraints. County staff and consultants will attempt to review plans submitted by May 4, 2011, but any inability of staff and consultants to do so will not constitute cause to extend the 5:00 p.m., May 18, 2011 deadline.
 - Plans submitted to the County become subject to the deliberations of the Redistricting Committee and may be revised or modified as the Redistricting Committee deems appropriate.
 - All plans submitted to the Redistricting Committee by the 5:00 p.m., May 18, 2011 deadline and which meet the five (5) submittal requirements listed in the General Instructions section above will be available for public review.
 - Proposed plans which meet the submittal requirements listed above and meet the 5:00 p.m., May 18, 2011 deadline will be considered at Redistricting Committee meetings. Persons proposing plans may wish to attend the meetings and testify on their plans. Attendance is not required.
 - Notice of Redistricting Committee meetings will be provided on the County website and as required by the Ralph M. Brown Act.

Timetable for Adoption of Supervisorial District Boundary Ordinance

The Redistricting Committee schedule of meetings is set forth in the Introduction above. Amendments and additions to the meeting schedule will be posted on the County website and available at the office of the Clerk of the Board. The Board of Supervisors will then hold a public hearing on or about July 26, 2011 to consider the recommendation of the Redistricting Committee and direct the County Surveyor to draft a redistricting ordinance. The Board of Supervisors will hold another public hearing on or about September 13, 2011 to consider adoption of the Supervisorial District Boundary Ordinance.

Adoption of the Ordinance by September 13, 2011 allows for the requisite 30-day period for the District Boundary Ordinance to become effective. During this time, the public has the right to challenge the Ordinance by referendum.
