## SENIOR ADVISORY

This advisory was prepared by the Orange County Office on Aging to help older adults protect themselves against 2010 Census related scams. It is important for older adults to be counted in the 2010 Census to ensure that Orange County receives its fair share of Federal funding for programs that benefit older adults. However, older adults should be aware of what the Census WILL ask and WILL NOT ask.

### CONFIDENTIALITY

Federal law protects your identity and the information you give to the Census.

Make Yourself Count! Census answers cannot be used against you in any way. Answering the 2010 census questionnaire is a simple way to do a lot of good for your community.

Individual Census responses are confidential and protected by the strongest national privacy laws on the books.

Completing the 2010 Census form will shape the future for you, your community and the country.

#### 10 QUESTIONS CENSUS WILL ASK

1. How many people?
2. Any additional people?
3. Owned, Rented
4. Phone number
5. Name
6. Gender
7. Age / Date of Birth
8. Hispanic or Latino origin?
9. Race
10. Temp residence

\* Seniors should be cautious of anyone claiming to conduct official Census business who requests information not pertaining to the above 10 questions.
