Claim Form for Deceased Estates Funds- Instructions

All Claims must be RECEIVED prior to the deadline

Periodically, the County Treasurer receives monies from estates of deceased persons. Monies received under Probate Code 11850 which have remained unclaimed for over one year are escheated to the State Controller. Monies received under Probate Code 7663 which have remained unclaimed for three years are escheated to the County.

To claim monies held under Probate Code 11850:

1. You must obtain a court order.
2. The court order must be received by the Office of the Treasurer before the deadline on the list.

To claim monies held under Probate Code 7663:

1. Fill out a claim form, sign it and have it notarized.
2. Obtain original documents (or true copies of originals) which establish with documentary proof the existence of a BLOOD RELATIONSHIP to either the decedent or the decedent's predeceased spouse.
3. The claim form and required documentation must be received by the Office of the Treasurer before the deadline.
